Derry Homegrown Farm & Artisans Market Opens up June 2nd.**

Derry, New Hampshire: After taking a one year hiatus due to Covid-19 concerns, the Derry Homegrown Farm & Artisan Market is gearing up for their fifth season beginning June 2nd 2021. **Receiving a 2019 Editor’s Choice Award for “Best Farmers’ Market in New Hampshire”** by *Yankee Magazine*, Derry Homegrown will run every Wednesday for eighteen weeks, June – September. Located at **1 West Broadway**, in the center of a bustling area of cafés, restaurants and retail in Derry’s Downtown, and right next to the Derry Rail Trail allowing easy access by car, bike and pedestrians. There is plenty of free parking available on street and at two municipal lots very close by.

As this will be our first season under Covid conditions, the Market may look somewhat different this year and masks will be required. While we enjoy making this a fun, community event, the health and safety of patrons, vendors and volunteers will be paramount this year.

The vendors participating this season will be bringing the area’s best to the community. Patrons should expect to be able to purchase ingredients for a complete meal, and be able to buy some grab and go foods as well. This year’s selection should include **fresh seafood, meats (beef, pork, lamb), eggs, produce, gourmet cheese, artisanal breads, pastries, chocolates, olive oils, jams, pickles, garlic, artisan pastas and sauces, locally sourced Puerto Rican cuisine, wine, beer, mead, natural soaps and more.**
